Wipe Out Kids' Cancer refers to pediatric cancer patients as "Warriors." This isn't just a word – it is truly a tribute to their strength, resilience, and courage. But we know that cancer impacts more than just the child. The entire family is greatly impacted: ...emotionally, financially, and socially.

That is why WOKC's **Warrior Family Program** is thoughtfully designed to support the patient AND every member of the family.

WARRIOR FAMILY ENTERTAINMENT

When a child is between treatments, **families desperately need moments of joy and connection.** The Warrior Family Entertainment gatherings offer free, fun-filled events that help restore some normalcy and happiness during a difficult journey. These events include amusement venues, concerts, college and professional sporting events, holiday parties, and other family-friendly social engagements enjoyed by Warriors and their families.



WARRIOR PARENT SOCIALS

Parents of critically ill children face exceptionally high stress, often leading to increased rates of divorce. **Warrior Parent Socials** provide free "date night" experiences (cooking classes, Karaoke, game show nights, etc.) with other parents navigating the pediatric cancer journey. These social gatherings not only allow couples to reconnect but also **help foster peer support systems and long-lasting family friendships.**

WARRIOR FAMILY ASSISTANCE

Many families with a child battling pediatric cancer also face food, housing, and energy insecurity as well as transportation challenges.

This initiative offers:

- Donated grocery gift cards to provide nutritious food at home, essential for their recovery
- Donated gasoline gift cards for traveling to and from hospital for cancer treatments



Research Funding



Wipe Out Kids' Cancer focuses on cutting-edge novel pediatric cancer innovations that represent advancements in treatment outcomes, which include **early detection, exponentially increased survival rates, less invasive treatments, and reduction of harmful side effects.**

WOKC's Scientific & Medical Research Committee carefully selects research studies that might not initially receive traditional funding. These innovations are critical and are **keeping scientists working toward advancements in medicine and treatments essential to serving WOKC mission.**

Since its humble beginning in 1980, **WOKC has significantly impacted pediatric cancer** through funding \$13 million of dollars in cutting-edge novel pediatric cancer research projects in almost every childhood cancer category. This seed money has yielded tens of millions of dollars in additional grants invested in further research discoveries to unlock the mysteries of pediatric cancer.

WOKC has funded numerous novel pediatric cancer research projects targeting medulloblastoma (brain tumors), numerous leukemias, bone tumors, sarcomas, Wilms tumor (kidney cancer), and neuroblastoma, as well as **advancing the use of alternative intelligence and machine learning (AI/ML) to speed up experimental validation and cures for cancer.**

WOKC has partnered with many of the top medical institutions in the country funding innovative and promising research leading to new discoveries and life-saving treatments in the fight against pediatric cancer.







This podcast is an opportunity to hear touching stories, experience genuine emotions, and find hope and encouragement.

Featuring Student Councils of DFW high schools competing against one another to see who can raise the most money for the mission of WOKC during a 40-day period in September and October. **The Luke Laufenberg Award** is presented to the schools who win the following categories: Most Money Raised, Best Fundraising Idea, Best Community Collaboration, and Best School Involvement. This program is the epitome of kids helping kids.

CONVERSATIONS WITH KIDS BEATING CANCER PODCAST



This podcast is a global initiative designed as a support component for kids when a cancer diagnosis is given. Kids with cancer experience a range of emotions (i.e.: fear, anger, isolation, "why me") following the diagnosis. Each podcast episode features a pediatric cancer survivor which helps to create a "safe space" to help validate those emotions.


